- 1. Buried "with Him"
- 2. Raised "with Him"
- 3. Made alive together "with Him"

COLO88iAN8 2:12, 13

12 buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,

A target of corruption!

False teachers contend that sinners are made disciples, then later they are baptized as an outward sign of an inward grace.

Make disciples > then baptize?

"Baptizing them" is how the command "make disciples" is fulfilled!

"He who believes and is baptized will be saved..." (Mk. 16:16)

Comparison

"Go clean the carpet,

1 picking up all the
toys, 2 vacuuming it."

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the <u>name</u> of the <u>Father</u> and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"

Name = Authority John 16:13-15

Where one's authority is, the other two's must be!
