Works of the flesh versus the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:16-23)



Crucify the flesh with its passions (Gal. 5:24)



Walk in the Spirit (Gal. 5:25)

- Had a wicked father who encouraged evil habits
 - 2 Kin. 16:1-4; 2 Chron. 28:19
- Rejected his father's course and removed wickedness
 - 2 Kin. 18:1-4
- Trusted in the Lord (2 Kin. 18:5, 6)
 - Trusted = ¹holding fast to the Lord, ² not departing from the Lord, ³ keeping His commandments
- Gave immediate service to repair the house of the Lord
 - 2 Chron. 29:3-5
