



Why the slaughter of animals?

"Then the king and all Israel with him offered sacrifices before the LORD. And Solomon offered a sacrifice of peace offerings, which he offered to the LORD. twenty-two thousand bulls and one hundred and twenty thousand sheep..." 1 Kin. 8:63

"Now the king went to Gibeon to sacrifice there, for that was the great high place: Solomon offered a thousand burnt offerings on that altar." 1 Kings 3:4

WHATIS THE PURPOSE THEN?

- 3 But in those *sacrifices there is* a reminder of sins every year.
- 4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.
- 5 Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me.
 - 6 In burnt offerings and *sacrifices* for sin You had no pleasure.

- 2. Sin kills innocent life!


